In an endeavor to promote spiritualism amongst our younger generation, we have been conducting competitions for school children based on our scriptures for the past 27 years.

Due to the pandemic ONLINE competitions were introduced in 2020 wherein students pan India participated for the last 2 years.

This year we are conducting competitions in both OFFLINE & ONLINE modes. While Offline Competitions are open to students from PAN India, Online Competitions are open to students only outside of Chennai.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. Online registrations only through our website www.jetchennai.org
- 2. Registrations are *limited* for each competitions as below:

SRI VISHNU SAHASRANAMAM	300 students for all Standards together
HAYAGRIVA STOTRAM	300 students for all Standards together
ASHTAKAAH	300 students for all Standards together
MUKUNDAMALA	300 students for all Standards together
QUIZ	100 students for each category
DRAWING	No limit

Online registrations for each competition will automatically close once the above mentioned numbers are reached.

- 3. After registrations are closed, ZOOM registration link(s) will be sent by email/Telegram to each participant with time slot mentioned for the participant. The participant should register in the Zoom link provided and they will then get a unique ZOOM ID to participate in the Competition. Separate Zoom registrations should be done if the child is participating in multiple competitions.
- 4. Competitions are open to students residing in India only.
- 5. Each student should use a separate email id at the time of registration same email id cannot be used for more than 1 student.

- 7. Initially, all correspondence will be by email.
- 8. Groups will be formed in TELEGRAM after registration. All correspondence will be through TELEGRAM once the groups are formed.
- 9. REQUIREMENTS at the time of registration: Mobile Number, Email ID, Passport Photo in *digital format* (not exceeding 200KB), Bank Account details.
- 10.All participants will receive e-Participation Certificates by email, which can be downloaded.
- 11. Any competition can be withdrawn, without prior notice, at the discretion of the organizers.

RULES

- 1. Online registration is a prerequisite to participate in the competitions.
- 2. Spot registrations will <u>not</u> be allowed or entertained.
- 3. Only the student registered for the competition will be allowed to participate *no proxy allowed*.
- 4. Students should participate only in video mode and using earphones only. (not on speaker mode)
- 5. Stable internet connection, downloading and familiarization of ZOOM and TELEGRAM are onus of the student/parents.
- 6. TIMINGS mentioned for each competition should be strictly adhered to and excuses such as disconnection due to power failure, internet connectivity issues, video not visible, etc. will not be entertained. Each student should recite the sloka when called upon and *no second chance will be given*.
- 7. Students will be allowed to participate in multiple competitions.
- 8. Only students with Registration number will be allowed to participate. Registration numbers will be generated online at the time of Registration.

- 10. Students should log into the Zoom App ONLY using their registered email id. Students will not be allowed to participate if they login using other email ids.
- 11.A MOCK SESSION will be held (date and time will be communicated later). Participation in the mock session is compulsory for all participants in order to iron out all doubts and clarifications before the competitions.
- 12.PRIZES will be announced at a later date and Prize Winners List will be published on our website www.jetchennai.org
- 13. All correspondence regarding the Competitions should be only through Email until the TELEGRAM groups are formed.
- 14. Any clarifications required should be only through TELEGRAM correspondence during the competitions. Any violation of this rule can attract disqualification.
- 15.All participants should stay in Mute Mode throughout the competitions. The participant will be unmuted by the moderator at the time of their turn for participation. The participant should at no point of time try to talk to the judges/moderator during the competitions.
- 16.DECISION of the judges/organizers are final and not subject to discussion.

QUIZ GUIDELINES

- 1. Quiz questions will be taken from the following books:
 - English Quiz Juniors Aranya Kaanda from Valmiki Ramayanam English Quiz - Seniors - Aranya Kaanda from Valmiki Ramayanam
- 2. Online Quiz will be conducted via **Kahoot** app.
- 3. All Participants are required to join ZOOM session & turn on cameras.
- 4. Participants will be required to toggle between the two apps (ZOOM and Kahoot) for every question. We recommend participants to join using laptop or desktop instead of mobile phones or use 2 devices (One for Zoom session and other to join Quiz)
- 5. Participants will be provided with Kahoot ID join Quiz via https://www.kahoot.it
- 6. Participants join Quiz through https://www.kahoot.it and should provide Kahoot ID (visible in ZOOM session) and registration number
- 7. Quiz questions will include:
 - a Multiple Choice Questions (single or multiple correct answers)

DRAWING COMPETITION – Guidelines

- 1. Drawing topics are based on Bhagavad Ramanuja. Details about him can be obtained from the website www.statueofequality.org OR by visiting the Statue of Equality OR from other texts on Bhagavad Ramanuja
- 2. A list of topics is given. Students are required to understand and be ready to draw on one of the topics listed. The Organizers will announce one topic for the competition 1 hour before the submission time.
- 3. The registered students should draw at the prescribed time only and upload the drawing in the link that will be provided (at the prescribed time).
- 4. A link will be provided in the Telegram Drawing Group for submission of the Drawing Sheet
- 5. The drawing sheet should be scanned and uploaded in the link provided.
- 6. Each student will be allowed to upload ONLY ONE drawing. If multiple drawings are uploaded, that student will be disqualified.
- 7. There will be a specific time schedule to upload your Drawing and you will not able be able to upload it at any other time.
- 8. Time schedule for upload will be announced after the close of Registrations.
- 9. All participants should clearly write their name, class, school name with city and your registration number (you will receive the registration number at the time of online registration.)
- 10. The Drawing should be done by the registered student only and should strictly not be done by anyone else.
- 11. Drawing can be in any form of your choice outline sketch, coloured, painted etc.
- 12. Decision of the Judges & organizers are final with respect to awarding of the PRIZES.
